

Now Hear This Custom Earplugs

My favorite motorcycle in our garage is the Triumph Tiger. Every chance I get I pick it to ride. The only issue I have with the bike is that it has an aftermarket Micron exhaust and my rides usually last 3 to 4 hours if not longer. That's quite some time in the saddle hearing the constant sound of a high-pitched pipe. Honestly, whenever I get off the bike, my ears ring for the remainder of the day, and that can't be good for anyone.

Finally, at this year's Honda Hoot, I took care of the problem and got some great earplugs. Marilyn Navia, an audiologist out of Florida, used a special syringe to squeeze pliable medical-grade silicone into my ears. A couple of minutes later they hardened and were ready for finishing. I had the chance to use them two days later on my ride to the mountains and what a

difference they made. I didn't hear the constant blaring of the pipes, but I was still able to hear an ambulance on the opposite side of the highway.

A good set of earplugs provides another specific advantage to motorcyclists: They help you relax. When things are quiet and peaceful, you don't get as tired during a ride. It's much easier to enjoy the experience and to ride more safely when you're relaxed.

Earplugs are the most overlooked pieces of safety equipment; and if you don't want to face the prospect of growing deaf later in life, I highly recommend a set of these custom earplugs.
